Dating back approximately 900 - 1,000 years, this castle is a prominent relic of ancient Khmer culture. Its carvings depict stories from Hinduism, particularly the epic of Ramayana, with numerous representations of Ramayana scenes. It is considered the site with the most Ramayana reliefs found in Thailand.
