

Meet with the local expert, a rice variety that is rich in calcium and minerals called Sangyod Rice. It is harvested annually. Additionally, you will gain knowledge on how to preserve seafood traditions and the products of local fisheries. Next, you will traverse the agricultural and residential zones.

The community-based tourism activity at Ban Klong Bor Sean, which is situated halfway to Phang Nga province, provides a break from the the journey. This village is remarkable in its ability to transform local products. "Look Chok," a palm with a round fruit containing tiny seeds. The husk undergoes a color transformation through high-temperature boiling, resulting in a brownish-colored indigo fabric, while the clear Jello flesh provides medicinal benefits.

Each visitor shows their creativity by constructing a straightforward design using an elastic band and an ice cream stick. They subsequently fold and tighten the design to produce a work of fabric art.

Khanom Ko, a traditional southern Thai dessert, is a savory dish made from their own farm product: tapioca powder, sugar, and crunched coconut, and is served to visitors as a break from the journey.

A remarkable company partners with the local community to produce a superior product made from recycled plastic straws. The weekend market in the village produces a substantial quantity of refuse. Destruction of plastic product refuse is exceedingly uncommon. The villagers are repurposing plastic straw by cutting it into an inch-long lengths and subsequently hand-knitting them into a fabric pillowcase. This item is the most cost-effective solution for individuals who are ill.

This is an excellent illustration of a community corporation that is dedicated to the well-being of the community and has created a local product that aligns with the medical standard for added value.

This herb has medical benefits for blood circulation, lymphatic health, and allergies when it is consumed as a tea or applied as a hygiene product to promote skin healing.
