  explore new business in Thailand. Site Inspection support provides not only travelling
  expense but also connection to relevant government agencies / associations which
  are essential to materialise the opportunities in Thailand.
- Marketing & PR Activity Once the idea is sorted out and new exhibition in Thailand is confirmed, this sub-support program will provide funding for organisers to hold press conference / launch event for their new show in Thailand.

Each sub-support program is capped at THB300,000
