*Required documents for all travellers to enter Thailand

- Certificate of Entry (COE) into Thailand
- "Fit to Fly" Health Certificate issued within 72 hours before departure
- A medical certificate showing Covid-19 negative, within 72 hours before departure
- A copy of Health Insurance with at least USD 100,000 medical expense

A traveller's journey under Tourist Visa - TR (Single Entry) to Thailand



Thai Embassy or Thai Consulate issues a COE and/or VISA

A traveller flies to Thailand with required documents* a traveller requesting for a Certificate of Entry (COE) by submitting the following

- Declaration form
- Medical Coverage
- ASQ /ALQ booking confirmation
- Flight booking confirmation
